

## **Does Nebraska have full reciprocity regarding teacher/administrator certification?**

Reciprocity is a term used when educators need to transfer their certification from one state to another. This does not mean that a state with “reciprocity” will automatically grant the same certificate or endorsements as was held in another state.

Each state has its own special requirements. Nebraska does accept recommendations from teacher preparation programs from state accredited colleges and universities in other states, but all candidates must meet the specific Nebraska requirements. Cases are evaluated on an individual basis.

In general, Nebraska does not recognize certificates or endorsements which have been granted by testing only and/or through alternative preparation programs.
