

My iPhoto Slideshow

In this assignment you will be inserting pictures taken on your Palm to create a slide show.

Requirements:

- Include information about some of the following to make five slides:
 - Your family—parents, siblings, etc.
 - Your hobbies and/or interests
 - Your likes and dislikes
 - Your pets
- Take pictures on your Palm relating to the items listed above.
- Download the pictures from your Palm to your Pictures folder.
- Use iPhoto to create a slideshow by importing your Palm pictures into iPhoto.
- Add a transition to every slide.
- Add an effect to one slide.
- Add music to your slideshow.
- Save your slideshow as a QuickTime movie.

Follow the requirements listed above and the steps given below to create your slideshow.

Instructions:


1. In your **Hard Drive**, click on **Applications**.
2. Scroll through to select **iPhoto**. Double click to open **iPhoto**.

Create an Album

1. To create a new album, click on the “Create a new album” button in the lower left half of the window.



2. Name the newly created album “My Slide Show.”



Import Pictures/Images

1. You will need to take at least five pictures with your Palm that relate to the categories mentioned above.
2. Hot sync the pictures to your computer. The pictures should be transferred to a folder called **PalmOne Photos** in the **Pictures** folder on your server.
3. Add the pictures to **iPhoto**. While in **iPhoto**, choose **Add to Library** from the **File menu**. Access the **Pictures** folder and **PalmOne Photos** folder to select your pictures.

4. Any pictures/images that you import are shown in the **iPhoto Library**. You will need to select all the pictures and drag the imported pictures into your newly created album.

5. Click on the *Slideshow* icon to start the creation of your slide show.



6. Using the slideshow toolbar, add a different transition for each image.




7. Using the slideshow toolbar, add an effect of *black and white or sepia* to one slide.

8. Click on the *Preview* button to see what the transition/effect does to your picture.

9. Click on *Adjust* to adjust the speed of the effect and the length of the “slide.”

10. Click on the double arrow to the right of the toolbar. Select *Settings*. Adjust the settings as shown below. Do not let it repeat, remove the Ken Burns effect, and select *Fit slideshow to music*.



11. To add music to your slideshow, select *Music* under the Settings option. Select a music clip you have saved in your Documents or Music folder. Make sure that *Play music during slideshow* is checked.

12. You are now done with your iPhoto slideshow and will save it as a *QuickTime* movie. Under the **Share menu**, select **Export**. Choose the folder to which you want to save your movie. Change the movie side to **Medium**. Click on **Export**.
