David Boyce, a Nebraska school certificate holder, you are hereby reprimanded for violating the standards of professional conduct and ethics. It has been reported that on October 5, 2011, you were found guilty of Commit Child Abuse Negligently, a Class I Misdemeanor, and DUI .15+ and sentenced to two (2) days in jail and one (1) year of probation, after being involved in a rollover accident with your three children while you were under the influence of alcohol. Your conduct is a violation of the following standard: Title 92, *Nebraska Administrative Code*, Chapter 27, Section 004.04E (effective date: November 12, 2003) which states, "the educator: Shall not commit any act of moral turpitude, or any felony under the laws of the United States or any state or territory, and shall not have a misdemeanor conviction involving abuse, neglect, or sexual misconduct as defined in Sections 003.12 through 003.14 of 92 NAC 21".

Any further unprofessional or unethical conduct may result in the suspension or revocation of your Nebraska school certificate.
