Clayton Gravatt, a Nebraska school certificate holder, you are hereby reprimanded for violating the standards of professional conduct and ethics. It has been reported that during the 2001-2002 and 2002-2003 school year, you were directed by the administration to refrain from having private one-on-one contact with students unless necessary for educational purposes, and on April 3, 2003, you were seen leaving the high school and driving to the country club to meet a female student. Your conduct is a violation of Title 92, Nebraska Administrative Code, Chapter 27, Section 004.03C (effective date: December 25, 1989) which states, "the educator: Shall make reasonable effort to protect the student from conditions which interfere with the learning process or are harmful to health or safety"; Section 005.02B2 (same effective date) which states, "Each teacher and special services counselor shall: Adhere to and enforce written and dated administrative policy of the school which has been communicated to the teacher or special services counselor"; and Section 005.09F (same effective date) which states, "Educators...: Shall comply with reasonable request and orders given by and with appropriate authority."

Any further unprofessional or unethical conduct may result in the suspension or revocation of your Nebraska school certificate.
