

Bobby Hurlburt, a Nebraska school certificate holder, you are hereby reprimanded for violating the standards of professional conduct and ethics. It has been reported that during the 2004-2005 school year you: 1) playfully gave a wedgie to one boy and assisted in the giving of a wedgie to another boy; 2) on one or two occasions used the words "damn" and "ass" in the classroom; 3) swatted two to three male students on the buttocks in a teasing manner; and 4) used students' names on the classroom board in vocabulary lessons that may have embarrassed students. Your conduct is a violation of Title 92, Nebraska Administrative Code, Chapter 27, Section 004.03C (effective date: November 12, 2003) which states, "the educator: Shall make reasonable effort to protect the student from conditions which interfere with the learning process or are harmful to health or safety"; and Section 004.03D (same effective date) which states, "the educator: Shall conduct professional educational activities in accordance with sound educational practices that are in the best interest of the student."

Any further unprofessional or unethical conduct may result in the suspension or revocation of your Nebraska school certificate.
