Jeffrey Koehler, a Nebraska school certificate holder, you are hereby reprimanded for violating the standards of professional conduct and ethics as superintendent of the Johnson-Brock Public Schools.

During the 2013-2014 school year, you failed to use reasonable diligence to ensure that only persons who are properly certified be employed as a teacher in the early childhood education program of the school district. In addition, you failed to promptly correct violations of the early childhood education program when notified of such violations by Department of Education staff.

Your conduct is a violation of Title 92, *Nebraska Administrative Code*, Chapter 27, Section 004.04F (effective date: November 12, 2003) which states, “the educator: Shall, with reasonable diligence, attend to the duties of his or her professional position”; Section 004.05C (same effective date) which states: “the educator: Shall practice the profession only with proper certification, and shall actively oppose the practice of the profession by persons known to be unqualified”; and Section 005.02C2 (same effective date) which states: Each administrator shall: Adhere to and enforce school law, state board regulation, and written and dated school board policy which has been communicated to the administrator.”

Any further unprofessional or unethical conduct may result in the suspension or revocation of your Nebraska school certificate.
