Michael Liesch, a Nebraska school certificate holder, you are hereby reprimanded for violating the standards of professional conduct and ethics. It has been reported that during the 1999-2000 school year, you made inappropriate comments to female students that made them feel uncomfortable, you made jokes of a sexual nature to students, and you failed to remove yourself from situations with female students that created an appearance by members of the public of an inappropriate student-teacher relationship. Your conduct is a violation of Title 92, Nebraska Administrative Code, Chapter 27, Section 004.02E (effective date: December 25, 1989) which states: "the educator: Shall not exploit professional relationships with students, colleagues, parents, school patrons, or school board members"; Section 004.02F (same effective date) which states: "the educator: Shall not sexually harass students, parents or school patrons, employees, or board members"; Section 004.03C (same effective date) which states: "the educator: Shall make reasonable effort to protect the student from conditions which interfere with the learning process or are harmful to health or safety"; and Section 004.03D (same effective date) which states: "the educator: Shall conduct professional educational activities in accordance with sound educational practices that are in the best interest of the student".

Any further unprofessional or unethical conduct may result in the suspension or revocation of your Nebraska school certificate.
