

Glennesia (Profit) Skipper, a Nebraska school certificate holder, you are hereby reprimanded for violating the standards of professional conduct and ethics. It has been reported that in November of 2008 you provided false information to investigators of the North Platte Police Department when questioned about a vehicle of yours being stolen. Subsequently, you pled no contest and were found guilty of False Reporting, a misdemeanor, in the Lincoln County Court, on April 10, 2009. Your conduct is a violation of Title 92, *Nebraska Administrative Code*, Chapter 27, Section 004.02D (effective date: November 12, 2003) which states, "the educator: Shall not make any fraudulent statement or fail to disclose a material fact for which the educator is responsible"; Section 004.04E (same effective date) which states, "the educator: Shall not commit any act of moral turpitude or any felony under the laws of the United States or any state or territory, and shall not have a misdemeanor conviction involving abuse, neglect, or sexual misconduct as defined in Sections 003.12 through 003.14 of 92 NAC 21"; and Section 005.09D (same effective date) which states, "Educators shall . . . : provide leadership and direction for others by appropriate example".

Any further unprofessional or unethical conduct may result in the suspension or revocation of your Nebraska school certificate.
