OVERVIEW

Our grant program, "Working with Wildlife," included programming by experts in the field. The local Nebraska Game & Parks Commission staff worked with KIDS Klub to arrange four local field trips to teach the students about their careers, outdoor safety, fishing, wildlife habitats, building tents, making fires, and analyzing lake water and owl pellets. The Lincoln Children's Zoo education staff conducted five hour-long Skype sessions with our students that featured many of their zoo animals and gave the children the opportunity to ask many questions and journal about what they learned. Zoo staff also traveled to North Platte for a two hour live animal show. The grant programming culminated in a day long field trip to the zoo with many scheduled activities on site including special behind-the-scenes looks at many areas of their facility.

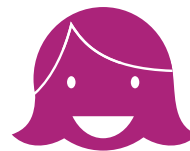

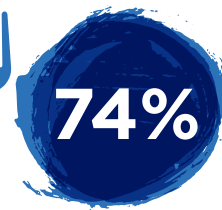
