English Language Arts (field) - Discussion: Higher Education institutions are concerned that candidates cannot be adequately trained in all the 7 areas of specialty with the current wording. Recommendation was made that theater, journalism, and digital literacies be moved to supplemental areas of endorsement. Also the quantifier of 9 hours should be removed. *Motion* to change the wording to read: “This endorsement shall require a minimum of 48 semester hours including content and pedagogical content coursework in literature, writing, language, communication, and reading literacy skills and strategies.” Motion was made by Habrock, seconded by Sears—MOTION PASSED
