SUBJECT: Visiting Teacher from China Program

The **Visiting Teacher from China Program** is being offered by the Nebraska Department of Education (NDE) and the Office of Chinese Language Council International (HANBAN). We continue to experience a national shortages of world language teachers. The Visiting Teacher from China Program provides local school districts with the opportunity to implement Chinese language education. With this program, Nebraska school systems have the option of recruiting highly qualified Chinese educators for a period of up to three years and at the same time provide Nebraska students, parents, and communities the opportunity to work with professionals from other countries. Visiting teachers from China are certified Chinese language educators with at least three years of experience. Local school districts hire the visiting teachers in accordance with all other local policies in terms of salary scale, certification, and local system requirements.

This program strives to:


- Promote cultural and educational relations that will benefit the State of Nebraska and China
- Foster knowledge and appreciation of the culture shared by these two global communities
- Foster an educational environment that supports both students and teachers in their continued and future effort toward personal, academic, and professional success

NDE will host a five-day orientation session for all first-year visiting teachers. Orientation activities include obtaining a social-security card, applying for a teaching certificate, and training in the code of ethics, technology resources, distance learning, Nebraska Foreign Language Frameworks, curriculum planning, assessment, instructional strategies/best practices, culture comparisons, school expectations, and classroom management. The orientation will be followed by a fall retreat to resolve challenges and concerns. NDE will assess a \$1200 fee per teacher to participating districts to cover food, lodging, and materials for the orientation training and follow-up weekend retreat.

Please disseminate this information to the school principals or respective officials in charge of hiring. If your school district is in need of a qualified Chinese teacher and might be interested in the program, please complete the Application of Intent survey, which is accessible online at www.education.ne.gov/forlg/VisitingTeachers.htm. This is an Application of Intent only and expresses a local school district's interest in participating in the Visiting Teacher from China Program for the 2010-2011 school year. It does not obligate the local school system to hire teachers from China. All Applications of Intent must be returned to the Nebraska Department of Education by **April 1, 2010**, to be considered.
