



Targeted Teaching Topic

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| Summary of Topic: Ethics Component |
| Main Curriculum Tie: Ethics. |
| Required Materials for Lesson: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• White board with markers.• Questions for review. |
| Background for Teacher: Material that you are teaching and made-up ethical situations. |
| Student Prior Knowledge: Knowledge of material studying and how to play tic-tac-toe. |
| Intended Learning Outcome: Review and think about opinion on ethical issues. |
| Instructional Procedure: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Split into two teams.• Create tic-tac-toe board and explain that the teams will play rock-paper-scissors to see who goes first.• Team picks a square and the teacher reads the questions.• If they answer right, they get the square. If they get it wrong, the other team can steal the square by answering it correctly.• If first team answers correctly, it is the other team's turn.• Keep playing until a team wins.• Once that happens, the team that won gets an ethical situation to discuss. Each student is expected to participate in discussion).• Can play a new game if time permits. |
| How to Measure Outcome: Informal assessment. Pay attention to what students do not understand in review and facilitate ethics discussion. |
