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Summary of Topic:

Interpreting Charts and Graphs

Main Curriculum Tie:

General diseases and disorders.

Required Materials for Lesson:

Graphs and/or charts of various diseases (i.e. cancer trends).

Background for Teacher:

Knowledge of charts and graphs.

Student Prior Knowledge:

How to read charts and graphs.

Intended Learning Outcome:

Learn how to properly read charts and graphs. Learn about various diseases.

Instructional Procedure:

- Students receive graph showing cancer trends.
- Student reads the graphs and interprets.
- Give questions:
 - What is the graph showing us?
 - What group had the highest rate?
 - What is the trend?
- Discuss.

How to Measure Outcome:

Can grade questions or just give points for discussion. Observation.
