



School Nutrition Equipment Grants Available




U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA), National Dairy Council, National Football League and GENYOUth have partnered via **Fuel Up to Play 60** to award \$35 million in grants to improve food service equipment and upgrade infrastructure critical to building healthy schools and communities.

The grants will assist School Nutrition Directors in the purchase of equipment that will provide students access to healthier meals that meet the updated national nutrition standards, with more whole grains, fruits, vegetables, lean protein and low-fat dairy, and less sodium and fat.
