

NEBRASKA SCIENCE OLYMPIAD

OFFICIAL SCORING POLICY



A review of scores will take place the Monday morning following the state competition. Scores will become final at 5:00 p.m. on the first Monday after the State Awards Ceremony. If it is determined that an error has occurred, adjustments to the final standings will be made and corrected trophies will be awarded but not taken away.

Final scores will be posted on the state website by 5:00 p.m. on the first Monday after the State Awards Ceremony. Any scoring inconsistencies affecting medals earned at the state competition must be brought to the attention of the state director within one week of the posting of final scores. Corrected medals will be awarded but not taken away.

At the Nebraska State Science Olympiad Tournament, trophies will be awarded to the top six teams in the Middle and High School Divisions. Medals will be awarded to the top six places in each middle and school event. If there are less than 12 teams competing in the competition or in an event, medals will only be given to the teams finishing in the upper half.
