Description of each grant program:

The Adult Education program provides basic skills instruction to those persons 16 years of age and older and withdrawn from school. Primary components of the program include: adult basic education (for those persons functioning at or below the 6th grade level); adult secondary education (for those persons functioning between the 7th-12th grade levels); and ESL (English as a Second Language – for those persons whose 1st language is not English). The four primary goals of persons enrolled in the program are: complete high school by successfully completing the GED tests; entrance into post-secondary education/training; obtain a job; and/or retain a job.

The EL/Civics Program serves those persons learning the English language and also receiving instruction in civics to become contributing members of their communities.

The Volunteer Coordination program provides funding for recruiting, training, and evaluating volunteers for the Adult Education classrooms.
