Background Information:

In the administration of these federal funds, the Nebraska Department of Education has awarded grants in 27 communities serving over 100 school building populations. This contract will continue the ongoing statewide evaluation of these programs. Evaluation training and technical assistance will also be provided by the contractor for new grantees and local evaluators. The contractor will assist NDE staff in the preparation of federal program evaluation reports and supporting grantees in the Continuous Improvement Process.

The amount of this contract is up to \$48,691 (Federal 21st CCLC).
