Background Information:

Nebraska Revised Statute 79-319 (15) establishes the State Board's responsibility to administer any device, donation, or bequest to NCECBVI. The Policy Committee has been designated as the Board committee to review annually the staff recommendations for expenditure of the Department's trust funds. The Policy Committee reviewed expenditures made in 2013 and the proposed 2014 Trust Fund Budget at the December, 2013 meeting. Approval of the Trust Fund Budget will allow the Department to access the trust funds during 2014 for support of NCECBVI as outlined in the attached budget proposal.
