

Nebraska Indicator (c) (12) Response

Indicator (c)(12) | *Of the students who graduate from high school consistent with 34 CFR 200.19(b)(1)(i) who enroll in a public IHE (as defined in section 101(a) of the HEA) in the State within 16 months of receiving a regular high school diploma, the number and percentage who complete at least one year's worth of college credit (applicable to a degree) within two years of enrollment in the IHE*

Nebraska will start reporting indicator C12 with its 2011 Cohort as outlined in the SFSF Grant application. The Nebraska Department of Education will utilize The National Student Clearinghouse to complete the necessary reporting requirements. As per the definition of indicator C12, of the students who enroll in a public institution of higher education in the State within 16 months of receiving a regular high school diploma, we need to identify students who completed at least one year's worth of college education within two years of enrollment. Considering the processing times required by The National Student Clearinghouse, Nebraska will be able to provide the C12 reports for the 2011 Cohort in September of 2015.
