

Excellence in Teaching Act Report to NCTE March 7, 2014

Enhancing Excellence in Teaching Program

The Enhancing Excellence in Teaching Program (EETP) provides forgivable loans to Nebraska teachers enrolled in a graduate program at a Nebraska institution. If the recipient meets the loan forgiveness obligations*, loans will be forgiven in an amount up to \$3,000 for each year of teaching or in an amount up to \$6,000 for each year of teaching if the student teaches in a school district that has been classified as very sparse or in a school building in which at least 40% of the students qualify for the poverty factor.

2009-10 – 268 \$809,000 awarded; \$750,000 disbursed

2010-11 – 321 \$700,000 awarded; \$640,000 disbursed (\$3000 limit)

2013-14 – 274 \$600,000 awarded; \$442,375 as of March 1, 2014

784 offered

16 declined

120 canceled by teaching – of those 119 still teaching 2013-14

*Loan Forgiveness Obligation: Teach full-time equivalent for 3 years after graduation




