1. Rule Status Updates—Sharon Katt

- Rule 25
- Rule 24—Effective August 1, 2012
School Counselor, School Librarian, Information Technology Education, English as a Second Language, Bilingual Education (new), Health Education, Health and Physical Education, Physical Education, Adapted Physical Education, Instructional Technology Leadership (new), Elementary Education, Principal, and School Psychologist endorsements have been revised/updated. Additional changes in the Rule include revision of the Provisional Special Education endorsement and the Provisional Endorsement (to align with Rule 21) and standardized “two years teaching experience” language across existing endorsements with that requirement.

3. Ad Hoc Committee Update/Progress—Pat Madsen

- Early Childhood Ad Hoc will meet again in September. Discussion is continuing. The June 18 meeting resulted in plans to introduce one Early Childhood Comprehensive endorsement, Early Childhood Education as a supplemental endorsement to Elementary Education, and Early Childhood Special Education (graduate). Preschool Disabilities will be eliminated and the Special Authorization Early Care will become part of the Early Childhood Comprehensive endorsement.

- Special Education Specialty Area Work Groups will meet in late September to work on the proposed Specialty Area endorsements, which will be supplemental endorsements to the proposed Special Education Generalist endorsement. The Ad Hoc Committee will then meet with plans to introduce all Special Education endorsements to the Executive Committee in January or March, 2013.
- Art/General Art and Middle Grades will be scheduled late fall/winter, 2012-2013.
