



Nebraska 21st CCLC Programs

2015-16 program statistics:

- 116 sites serving 30 communities
- 19, 745 students/62% attending 30 days or more
- \$5.5 million awarded
- 68% students qualify for free reduced lunch
- 61% ethnic minorities
- 18% special education
- 15% English language learners



Three Overarching Goals of 21st CCLC

Improve student learning performance in one or more core academic areas

Increase social benefits and positive behavioral changes

Increase family and community engagement in supporting students' education

Academic Support

STEM

- 72% Meet/Exceed Standards in Mathematics
- 79% Meet/Exceed Standards in Science

College & Career Ready

Student Survey Data

Getting a college education is important to me:
3.67/4.0 (Average Score)

Youth Engagement Secondary Survey

I am planning to go to college: 1.78/2.0



Social and Emotional Growth

Teacher survey data:

Participation in class and academic performance had the highest improvement rates.

Student survey data (1.0 – 4.0):

“This program has helped me to complete my schoolwork on time” had an average rating of 3.29.



Family & Community Engagement

On a scale of 1.0 - 4.0, parent surveys rated 21st
CCLC:

3.81 for overall satisfaction

3.89 that the “21st CCLC program is a great
benefit to my child/youth”

79% of family members report visiting school

72% review homework and support learning at
home
