An e-mail needs to be sent to the membership about the constitution for the NAATF. The plan is to have an electronic vote on the constitution after the first of the year. Article VI of the Nebraska AATF constitution regarding officers was discussed. Since we only have one meeting a year, it was thought that the dates would need to be changed. The Executive Board will meet to work out dates for electronic elections and notify and post the proposal for members to vote on.

The meeting concluded with a discussion of organizing a Salon to discuss officers for next year before the end of the school year. There was also a discussion on recruiting new members and getting other French teachers involved. A motion was made and seconded to adjourn the meeting, and it was adjourned at 3:45 p.m.
