



Nube Goes to the Children's School – Nube Va a la Escuela de los Niños

Objectives:

The students will...

- demonstrate knowledge of commands through actions.
- demonstrate comprehension of “Nube Va a la Escuela” by acting out the story as it is told in the target language.
- apply knowledge of things in a classroom through a variety of activities
- demonstrate their knowledge of the target language through routine classroom activities
- Apply their knowledge of numbers, days of the week, months of the year, and weather expressions in classroom routines

Anticipatory Set

Have the students create a “little school book” including all the different objects found in a classroom. You can print the school book from the following site if you are a member, or you can have the students draw and color their own following the example on this site.

Nube Va A La Escuela de los Niños

Aquí viene el autobús de la escuela. ¡Guau, Guau!

Here comes the school bus. Bow Wow!

Los perros no van a la escuela

Dogs don't go to school.

Nube va al parque

Nube goes to the park.

Nube va a la escuela de los niños.

¡Guau, Guau!

Nube goes to the children's school Bow wow!

Nube juega con la pelota

Nube plays with the ball.

Nube está en la clase. Se encuentra al maestro y a los estudiantes

Nube is in the class. He meets the teacher and the students.

Digan los nombres, estudiantes.

Nube dice, "Guau, Guau."

Say your name, students.

Nube says, "Bow wow."

Presten atención, estudiantes.

Nube presta atención.

Pay attention, students.

Nube pays attention.

Escuchen al maestro.

Nube escucha al maestro

Listen to the teacher.

Nube listens to the teacher.

Levanten las manos.

Nube no levanta la mano.

Raise your hands.

Nube doesn't raise his hand.

Abran los libros y lean.

Nube no abre el libro y no lee porque no hay libros para perros.

Open the books and read.

Nube doesn't open the book and doesn't read because there are no books for dogs.

Vayan a la pizarra y escriban.

Nube va a la pizarra pero no escribe.

Go to the board and write.

Nube goes to the board but doesn't write.

Escriban en los papeles.

Nube no escribe porque no tiene papel.

Write on paper.

Nube doesn't write because he has no paper.

A Nube le gustan a los estudiantes.

A los estudiantes les gusta a Nube.

Nube likes the students.

The students like Nube.

Input

- Have the students TPR key words from the story
- Tell the story in the target language using the power point presentation

Guided Practice

- Have the students sequence pictures from the story and match them with their corresponding captions.
- Have the students list all of the things in the target language that Nube did at school.

Extension Activities

- Practice school vocabulary in the following ways:
 - Match the picture of the classroom object with its corresponding word in the target language
 - As a class, say “La Clase” chant in Spanish adding additional objects to the chant.
 - Conduct a Scavenger Hunt with objects in the classroom
 - Read school clues in English and have students tell what the clue describes in the target language.
 - Play concentration or the memory game with flashcards of classroom objects
 - Write classroom objects in the target language on Post It notes and then have the students place the Post It notes on the correct object in the classroom.
- Practice commands in the classroom in the following ways:
 - Have students TPR classroom commands in the target language
 - Give the students the command in the target language and have the students TPR the action
 - Show the visual of the command and have students say it in the target language





Evaluation

- Check comprehension of the story with simple yes/no questions or either/or questions.
- Do a stand and share activity where the students each share one part of the story.
- Say commands and have the students act them out.

Closure

- Retell the story and have the students fill in the blanks when the teacher pauses.
- Students can retell the story with a partner.

Extension Activities using Regular Classroom Routines

- Greet students in the target language **Buenos días. Bienvenido**
- Ask simple questions in the target language such as
 - What is your name? **¿Cómo te llamas?**
 - How old are you? **¿Cuántos años tienes?**
 - What is your favorite color? **¿Qué es tu color favorito?**
 - When is your birthday? **¿Cuándo es tu cumpleaños?**
 - How are you? **¿Cómo estás?**
 - Do you understand? **¿Comprendes?**
- Go over the daily calendar asking such questions as the following:
 - What month is it? **¿Qué mes es?**
 - What is the date today? **¿Qué es la fecha hoy?**
 - What day is today? **¿Qué día es hoy?**
 - What day was yesterday? **¿Qué día fue ayer?**
 - What day is tomorrow? **¿Qué día es mañana?**
 - How many days are in this month? **¿Cuántos días hay en este mes?**
 - Count in the target language the number of days up to that date.
- Ask questions concerning the weather each day and what clothing you should wear in that type of weather **¿Qué tiempo hace hoy?**
- Give instructions in the target language.

- At any opportunity, use the name of the object in the classroom in the target language instead of English: “Where is your paper?”
- Closing – tell students you will see them tomorrow in the target language
Hasta mañana.

Other Classroom Activities

- Label the items in the classroom
- Put courtesy expressions on the wall

I'm sorry – **lo siento** excuse me – **con permiso**
 thank you – **gracias** por favor – **please**
 salud – **bless you** de nada – **you're welcome**

- Use a transition rhyme when you start to teach Spanish such as
¡Uno, dos, tres – no más ingles!

- Have native speaker students teach a new word a day
- Post a daily schedule of subjects in Spanish

math – **matemáticas** Spanish – **español**
 English – **inglés** music – **musica**
 science – **ciencias** physical education – **educación fisica**
 art – **arte** social studies – **estudios sociales**
 reading – **lectura** recess – **hora de recreo**

- Take role, lunch count etc. in different ways using Spanish. For example, the students might say **aquí** (here), name objects found in the classroom in Spanish, say the colors in Spanish, count in Spanish etc.
