



Targeted Teaching Topic

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Summary of Topic:

Review of the Bones of the Human Body

Main Curriculum Tie:

Bones of the human body (structure and function).

Required Materials for Lesson:

- Paper with names of major bones written on separate pieces of paper.
- Skeleton.

Background for Teacher:

Bones of the human body and where they are located.

Student Prior Knowledge:

Major bones of the human body and where they are found on the body.

Intended Learning Outcome:

Review the locations of the major bones of the human body.

Instructional Procedure:

- The teacher will place the names of the bones in a cup.
- Each student will draw a bone and then locate the bone on a skeleton. Students should say the name of the bone while pointing to the location in order to help all students review all of the bones.

How to Measure Outcome:

Did each student locate their bone on the skeleton? Students' ability to locate the bones on the skeleton.
