

Title: Our City at Work

Objective:

- Students will explore places of employment in the community.
- Students will describe why businesses are helpful to a community.

Materials and Supplies Needed:

- Map of community
- Construction paper
- Scissors
- Sticky note flags

Class Instructions:

- 1. Hang a map of your community in the classroom at a height accessible to the students.
- 2. Discuss the map with students, having them point out places of employment.
- 3. Make small flags; label them, then attach the flag to the appropriate address on the map.
- 4. Discuss what kinds of work people do at the various locations and the importance of this work to the community.
