



Title: Character Needed for a Career

Grade: K

Career Development Model:

Self-Awareness • Career Planning & Management

Nebraska Career Readiness Standards:

Objective:

- Students will recognize that their actions demonstrate their character.
- Students will state character traits they are practicing in elementary that are necessary for a future career.
- Students will explain how good character traits are important career readiness skills.

Materials and Supplies Needed:

- List of Character Traits: Trustworthiness, Fairness, Caring, Responsibility, Respect
- Chart paper or Marker board
- Character Worksheet

Class Instructions:

1. Place the List of Traits on the board one at a time. For each trait discuss what that looks like at SCHOOL and what that would look like for a CAREER. Make a T chart on the board. One side of chart being School and other side being Career.
2. Once all traits are discussed write the sentence: I am TRUSTWORTHY when _____.
3. Model filling in the sentence and drawing a picture.
4. Have students pick 2 character traits and write the sentence and draw a picture of themselves showing that a SCHOOL and for a CAREER.
