**Purpose:** To provide information about Nebraska school district responsibilities related to data reporting and assessments:

- Who is responsible for reporting data about a student (and possible templates necessary to be submitted);
- Who is responsible for ensuring State NeSA Assessments are provided to students;
- What district does student performance data become attached to for purposes of accountability and public reporting.

The scenarios and different situations among Nebraska schools are unique and diverse, but the information provided within this publication intends to provide clarity on different situations.

If staff left during the year you must include them with a completion date on their position assignment.
