

## State of the Schools Report (SOSR) Data Submission Timeline

**NOTE: The dates for the submission of Completer Data have changed a bit (see below). Completer data includes the follow-up for students who completed since last year (summer completers) or did not complete and should now be recorded as drop-outs. This data is critical to the new graduation rate calculations using cohort data.**

July 1 – July 30	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Districts review data, including AYP decisions, on the SOSR</li> <li>District submit AYP Appeals and Requests to Change Data</li> <li>NDE approves Appeals and Requests</li> <li>NDE staff audit data and contact districts that need to change data or submit data</li> <li>NSSRS is closed to districts (upgrades installed)</li> </ul>
August 3 – August 14	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>NSSRS open to districts to resubmit data related to approved Requests to Change Data</li> </ul>
August 24	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>NSSRS opens for submission of Fall 2009-10 data</li> </ul>
October 5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>SOSR is open to the public with AYP results but no NCLB qualified teacher data</li> </ul>
October	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>NCLB Qualified data is available on the SOSR Preview site</li> <li>Districts submit Requests to Change Data if needed</li> </ul>
<b>November 4 - 13</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>NSSRS is open for submission of 2008-09 data for dropouts and completers</b></li> </ul>
November 18	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>NCLB Qualified Data is added to the public SOSR (the SOSR Preview is closed)</li> </ul>

## No Child Left Behind Allocations for 2009-10

The NCLB allocations for 2009-10 are now posted, in pdf files, on the NCLB homepage at: <http://www.nde.state.ne.us/federalprograms/index.htm> The Title I file contains the amounts of each of the grants (Basic, Concentration, Targeted and Education Finance Incentive Grants or EFIG) that are combined to provide the total allocation for the district. The Department is reallocating the required reservation of Section 1003(a) funds from last July so each eligible district has a reallocation amount.

The Titles II through IV provides the amounts known at this time for Title II, Part A (Teacher Quality) and Title II, Part D (Enhancing Education Through Technology formula). The remaining allocations will be added as soon as possible and notice of changes sent through these bulletins. There is no Title V (Innovative Programs) funding for 2009-10. Districts that are REAP eligible can still use REAP-FLEX to use funds from other programs for the purposes of Title V
