

NSSRS/CDC

All year-end templates and reports in the Nebraska Student and Staff Record System (NSSRS) and the Consolidated Data Collections (CDC) are due on June 30.

State of the Schools Report Preview (found in the Portal under the Data Collections tab)

Until June 30, districts can preview their data on the Report Card the day after it is submitted. The charts for the NSSRS and CDC timelines are included below.

SPED Snapshot Error 298 Special Education Students Listed At more Than One District (Year End Snapshot)

Some schools are getting the above error in NSSRS for SPED students that transferred between schools during the school year. Unfortunately, it is not as simple as deleting the duplicate record from the originating school. A new, updated SRS file must be generated for NSSRS's SPED Snapshot requirements, and the file reloaded into NSSRS.

Procedure:

In the reports tab in **SRS**, click on the link to go to **NSSRS Transfers**, and create a transfer report for the student(s) for which they are getting errors on. Follow the rest of the procedures in their school for getting that file uploaded into the NSSRS batch manager. In the future, the SPED data steward should fill out the transfer code/transfer date before sending the records on.

Completers Alert

Completers in NSSRS should be reported on or before June 30th, 2009 in the School Enrollment Template. If you have summer Completers they can be reported in the Fall. Please do not code any students as a Completer:Diploma ([School Enrollment: Enrollment Code (7)] = 203) unless your district awarded a diploma to the student. If you have students that attended your district part-time (i.e. students from nonpublic systems or home schooled student) and are not returning to your district next year, use Enrollment Code 201 (Transfer out) to exit these students from your district.

For public districts serving Nonpublic or Home Schooled students with special education services that are completers in the Nonpublic system or Home School.

You will follow the instructions above so the student isn't counted as a completer in both the Public and Nonpublic system. You will also have to submit the Special Education Snapshot Template for these students. The Special Education Snapshot should include an Exit Date [Special Education Snapshot:Special Ed Exit Date (34) and Exit Reason [Special Education Snapshot:Primary Exit Reason Code (52)]. If the student received a regular high school diploma from the nonpublic the Exit Reason will be 3. If the student received a certificate of completion from the nonpublic the Exit Reason will be 4.

All ESEA ARRA Consolidated Applications are due June 26. See table below.

| June 26, 2009 | ARRA ESEA Application for Title I, Part A closes. If no application is received by this date, we are assuming the district does not intend to apply and the ARRA Title I funds will be released for later reallocation. |

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| June 30, 2009 | All ARRA ESEA Title I application must be approved |
| July 1, 2009 | ARRA Title II, Part D funds become available. This is not a separate application but an amendment of the ARRA ESEA Consolidated Application to add in ARRA Title II, Part D. |
| August 5, 2009 | The ARRA ESEA Consolidated Application closes. Amendments adding in the ARRA Title II, Part D application must be submitted by this date. If no amendment (adding ARRA Title II, Part D) is submitted by this date, we are assuming the district does not intend to apply and the ARRA Title II, Part D funds will be released for later reallocation. |
| August 25, 2009 | All ARRA ESEA Consolidated Applications must be approved. |
| August 26, 2009 | Tentative Date for the NCLB Consolidated Application for 2009-10 opens. |
| October 9, 2009 | NCLB Consolidated Application closes. |
