TWO NEBRASKA STUDENTS NAMED AP SCHOLARS

Two students from Millard Public Schools recently were named AP Scholars for their outstanding performance on the 2015 College Board's advanced placement exams.

Zachary Warneke of Millard South High School and Thwisha Sabloak of Millard West High School were among students nationwide to receive this recognition.

The State AP Scholar Award is an academic distinction acknowledging students who have earned the score of 3 or higher on the greatest number of AP exams and the highest average scores of at least 3.5 on all AP exams taken. The awards are presented annually to one male student and one female student from each state and the District of Columbia.

The College Board's AP program provides students the opportunity to take rigorous college-level courses while still in high school and to earn college credit.
