NEBRASKA VR, COMMISSION FOR DEAF, HARD OF HEARING COLLABORATE ON CLIENT EVALUATION PROGRAM

Nebraska VR recently announced a new collaboration with the Nebraska Commission for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing (NCDHH).

NCDHH will participate in Nebraska VR's On-the-Job Evaluation program. Nebraska VR clients will work with the Commission to help to determine their true interests for future employment.

"Participation in this paid internship program will enable NCDHH to work closely with Nebraska VR in our shared goal of increasing the number of successful employment outcomes for Nebraskans who are deaf, hard of hearing or deaf and blind," NCDHH Executive Director John Wyvill said.

Based on their job skills and the ability to learn new skills, clients who are evaluated will be able to determine their interests for future work.

"We are pleased to partner and collaborate with NCDHH. Our shared purpose is to provide opportunities to individuals from the deaf and hard of hearing community to go to work and succeed. These on-the-job evaluations will provide information to help identify client skills and abilities so this new evaluation site will truly be where their future begins," Nebraska VR Director Mark Schultz said.
