Your knowledge of the progressions of development and learning for each objective enable you to quickly determine the developmental levels of children in your program so you can plan instruction appropriately. Intentional curriculum planning and differentiated teaching, based on what children know and can do, are essential. The best way to capture what children know and can do is by

- Observing them in the context of their everyday experiences,
- Analyzing the information collected, and
- Scaffolding children's learning within the framework of your curriculum.
