
Electronic Feedback

Draft Mathematics Standards

- Standards Input Email – 14 responses
 - 10 were individuals (one individual sent 2 emails)
 - 3 were from groups of educators
- Electronic Survey – 253 responses
 - 224 were individuals
 - 29 were from groups of educators




Who Responded?

Key Themes from Comments

- Most concentrated at Grades 9 – 11
- Specificity of the standards was complimented
- Many questions regarding the relationship with NeSA Math
- Need for professional development was reinforced



Key Themes from Comments

- Major content suggestions/comments:
 - ✓ Appropriateness of topics and grade-levels
 - ✓ Sub-categories provide better organization
 - ✓ Rewording suggestions
 - ✓ Suggestion of potentially missing topics
- Addressing the suggestions and comments will help focus edits and strengthen the document
