




90,010 STUDENTS took a Career Education course in the 2014-15 school year.

There were 155,035 total students (grades 6-12).







Descriptive Statistics: Completer with Diploma All High School Seniors vs. Concentrators



90% of Nebraska high school seniors completed an approved program of study and met district/system requirements for a high school diploma



99% of CTE Concentrators completed an approved program of study and met district/system requirements for a high school diploma
