NEBRASKA STUDENTS AWARDED SEALS OF BILITERACY

The Nebraska Department of Education and the Nebraska International Language Association have awarded 101 Seals of Bilingualism to 71 Nebraska students this semester. Besides Spanish, the seals are awarded for students in Chinese, French, Korean, and Tamil.

The Nebraska Seal of Bilingualism is to honor high school students who have achieved a high level of proficiency in English and at least one other language.

Students apply for the Nebraska Seal of Bilingualism after demonstrating proficiency based on the Nebraska World Language Standards structured around communication, cultures, connections, communities, and cognition within a language other than English.
