



STATE SUBSTITUTE TEACHING PERMIT RENEWAL FOR NEBRASKA CERTIFICATION

The State Substitute Teaching Permit is valid for five (5) years and authorizes teaching in any subject at any level with unlimited number of days of teaching. However, not more than ninety (90) days may be taught in the same assignment (same class or subject to the same students).

The following documents must be submitted for renewal of the State Substitute Teaching Permit:

- The Application form and non-refundable application fee online at www.education.ne.gov/tcert OR Print, complete, sign and date the Application form from the Supporting Forms link at www.education.ne.gov/tcert and your payment by check or money order AND
- Verification on the state NSSRS system of fifty (50) days of substitute teaching within five (5) years prior to the date of application OR
- Official transcript of three (3) semester hours of graduate college credit in education completed within five (5) years prior to the application date.
