Alignment with AQuESTT

- **Career Education part of each of the six tenants**
 - Rubric to impact school rating
 - Data and information to inform and support quality schools



Primary RTAM Focus

- **Federal Monitoring**
 - Areas of finding are fixed
- **Focus on Areas Identified as Concerns**
 - Major concern for state audit findings
 - Potential areas of federal audit finding
- **Data Issues**
 - Course coding, Concentrators, etc.



Advisory Councils

- **Areas of Concern**
 - Need diverse representation
 - Consortium advisory councils cannot be a team of school administrators
 - Must have parents, business/industry, community, etc.
 - Meet at least once a year to provide advice on where to spend Perkins funds



Uses of Funds

- **Areas of Concern**

- Each LEA must address all nine uses - no longer state aggregate
- If use of fund is checked, must align with the goals and activities listed
- Do not just check all boxes for all activities
- Must have all nine checked for one or more goals/activities



Uses of Funds

- **Nine Required Funds**

1. Strengthening the academic, career and technical skills of students in CTE
2. Link CTE at the secondary/postsecondary level
3. Provide experiences in all aspects of the industry



Uses of Funds

- **Nine Required Funds**

4. Develop, improve or expand technology in CTE
5. Provide professional development
6. Develop and implement evaluation of CTE programs with emphasis on special populations



Uses of Funds

- **Nine Required Funds**

7. Initiate, improve, expand or modernize CTE
8. Provide services and activities that are of sufficient size, scope and quality
9. Provide activities to prepare special populations



Uses of Funds

- **Areas of Concern**

- Must focus on all CTE programs in the consortium, especially with professional development and special population students
- Not all consortium members or programs must participate equally, but must have the opportunity to participate



Uses of Funds

- **Areas of Concern**

- Review eligible and non-eligible uses of funds
- Consumables are not eligible
- Non-eligible guidelines
 - Must be occupational preparation
 - Must be industry grade equipment

- Performance Measure Goals
- 13-14 Performance
- Report Cards
 - Analysis by sub-population
 - Analysis by career field



Data Issues

- **Areas of Concern**

- If miss 3 years in a row, NDE must require the investment of Perkins dollars to address the measure until measure is met.



Data Issues

- **Monitoring**

- Our current plan was to have a rotational monitoring
- Continue with rotation, but will add a risk assessment that will trigger a monitoring visit
 - Fiscal or data issues
 - Late submissions or late amendments
