

Title II Higher Education Act Quality of Teacher Preparation Report 2017 Institution Report Summary

During the 2015-2016 academic year, there were sixteen (16) approved teacher education programs in Nebraska. In addition to the requirement that all Nebraska institutions successfully complete the state approval process, thirteen (13) institutions hold national accreditation by the Council for the Accreditation of Educator Preparation.

Institutions are required to submit annual reports in compliance with *Title II of the Higher Education Act* (HEA) of 2008. Information reported in the HEA institutional report includes institution goals; basic skills and content test information; admission requirements; candidate characteristics; clinical experience; student enrollment; and program completer/certification information. For purposes of these reports, an academic year is defined as September 1 – August 31.

The institutional reports were submitted in April 2017. The following table summarizes the 2015-2016 enrolled candidate and program completer information for each of the 16 institutions.
