
The new CTE course standards and benchmarks for each of the six career fields were crosswalked with the Nebraska Academic Standards and the Common Core State Standards and are now available at <http://cestandards.education.ne.gov/>. The crosswalks clearly identify the important role that CTE course content has in supporting and enhancing the academic core. This crosswalk process was produced in collaboration with the North Central Comprehensive Center and the Standards Team Analysts at McREL.

Linked to this same website are the state-approved programs of study for each career field. Programs of study include a minimum of three one-semester courses.
