

# **Targeted Teaching Topic**

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## **Summary of Topic:**

Traits of a Family / 7<sup>th</sup> Life Science

# **Main Curriculum Tie:**

How family members can have similar or different traits.

#### **Required Materials for Lesson:**

- Cards with dominant and recessive traits.
- Body outline to sketch offspring traits (earlobes, eye spacing, hair, eyelashes, etc.)

#### **Background for Teacher:**

Genetic dominant and recessive traits.

#### **Student Prior Knowledge:**

Dominant and recessive traits.

## **Intended Learning Outcome:**

The students will get a better grasp of how dominant and recessive traits.

#### **Instructional Procedure:**

- Have a set of dominant and recessive alleles for the mother and the father.
- Students draw 1 trait card from each parent and sketch their offspring.

#### **How to Measure Outcome:**

Class discussion on dominant and recessive traits with students discussing how they are passed on.
