Summary of Topic: Health Care
Main Curriculum Tie: Medicare.
Required Materials for Lesson: Student journals.
Background for Teacher: Knowledge of health care, major characteristics of Medicare, Medicaid and Worker's Compensation.
Student Prior Knowledge: Have students prepare KWL chart on health care.
Intended Learning Outcome: Explore the concept of health care and identify the major concepts of Medicare, Medicaid, and Worker's Compensation.
Instructional Procedure: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Have the students write the following questions in their journal and not only answer how but reflect on them:<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ What do you do when you get sick?○ How does your family get help for you?○ Many people get sick and are not able to get treatment. Think about the following:<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ What happens when a poor person gets hurt or injured?▪ What happens when an elderly person needs medicine?▪ How do disabled people who cannot work pay for housing, food, and medicine?▪ How do poor people who no longer have families to take care of them get help when they are sick?
How to Measure Outcome: Compare pre-KWL to post KWL to see what has been learned.
