



Targeted Teaching Topic

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Summary of Topic:

Pin the Tail on the Body

Main Curriculum Tie:

Practice with anatomical directions and locations.

Required Materials for Lesson:

Front and back silhouettes of a full human body. Draw as gingerbread man on butcher paper or display off an overhead.

Background for Teacher:

Know your stuff.

Student Prior Knowledge:

Beginning learning on anatomical directions and locations.

Intended Learning Outcome:

Better retention of anatomical directions and locations.

Instructional Procedure:

- On an open wall or projected onto a white board, display the front and back silhouettes of the human body.
- Have students take turns placing a mark or marker on the silhouettes based on the description of an anatomical direction or location.

How to Measure Outcome:

Improved knowledge of anatomical directions and locations as evidenced on quizzes and tests.
