Summary of Topic:

Students will identify anatomical structures in systems.

Main Curriculum Tie:

Human structure and function.

Required Materials for Lesson:

- “Post-its”.
- Cellophane tape.
- Sharpie marker.

Background for Teacher:

Knowledge of anatomical structures found in a particular system.

Student Prior Knowledge:

Major structures and function of a particular body system.

Intended Learning Outcome:

Learn anatomical terminology for various structures.

Instructional Procedure:

- Write the name of an anatomical structure located within a chosen body system on a “post-it” note.
- Attach the “post-it” to the back of each student using different structures for each.
- Using questions addressed to other students; determine the assigned structure using responses of “yes” or “no”.
- Try again with a different structure when correctly identified.

How to Measure Outcome:

Have a set amount of time; try to name as many structures as possible.
