Summary of Topic:

Tally Seatbelt Usage Amongst Students/Staff at Your School.

Main Curriculum Tie:

Public safety.

Required Materials for Lesson:

- Students.
- Small candy.
- Paper/pen for tallying.

Background for Teacher:

Organization.

Student Prior Knowledge:

Teamwork.

Intended Learning Outcome:

Tally how many students/ staff wear seat belts to school.

Instructional Procedure:

- 2 or more students positioned at entrance of parking lot or street entering school.
- Check people driving in wearing seatbelts (get candy), no belts (no candy).
- Tally percentage of people wearing belts.
- National average: 68% wear seatbelts. Are you above or below average?

How to Measure Outcome:

Tally total number of drivers with seatbelts in Fall and again in Spring.
