





CHILD COUNT




- Age 3-21
- Resided in a Nebraska Project between 9/1 and 8/31
- MIS2000: Has enroll or withdraw date between 9/1 and 8/31

AT-RISK




- Age 3-21
- Resided in a Nebraska Project between 9/1 and 8/31
- Is failing or at-risk of failing to meet the state standards
- MIS2000: At least one “Need” checked AI-AII

PRIORITY FOR SERVICE




- Age 3-21
- Resided in a Nebraska Project between 9/1 and 8/31
- Is failing or at-risk of failing to meet the state standards and education has been interrupted during the regular school year based on the Migrant Lifestyle.
- MIS2000: At least one “Need” checked AI-All and one checked BI-B4




PRIORITY FOR SERVICE - SERVED



QUALITY CONTROL – NE STATE ID

[AS OF 5/19/17]

- Nebraska State ID – A unique ID given to a child who is attending a Nebraska school.
- Grades K-12
- Data Entry Requirement: Each eligible child attending a K-12 school must have a NE State ID in MIS2000
- MIS2000: located at the upper right corner in the top panel. Collected and entered by the project's data entry specialist.

NEBRASKA STATE ID




QUALITY CONTROL – VERIFICATION DATE

(AS OF 5/19/17)

- Verification Date – used to validate that a migrant child has been verified by the project to have resided for at least one day during the performance period (9/1 - 8/31)
- Data Entry Requirement: By September 30th of each year, every eligible migrant child must have a Verification Date of September 1st or later.
- MIS2000: located in the School History panel.

PREPARING FOR SUMMER ENROLLMENTS

- Report – 0-21 Student List (run this list before and after updating enrollments)
 - Filters
 - School Year = 16/17
 - Project ID = [YOURID]
 - Start Date = 08/01/16
 - End Date = 08/31/17
 - Make sure all eligible students are included in the report
 - Withdraw Date: Anyone with a blank withdraw date, needs to be updated in MIS
 - Type: Anyone who is given a summer enrollment should show Type S

2017-2018 DATA COLLECTION CHANGES - ENROLLMENTS

- COE Change of Data Requests – requests submitted through a change of data form, email, or phone call requesting a revision to an Accepted COE
- September 2016 to March 2016 – 362 COE Change of Data Requests
 - 193 of these were changes to COE enrollment data
 - 53% of COE Change of Data Requests submitted are related to incorrect Data entered on COE enrollment fields

2017-2018 DATA COLLECTION CHANGES - ENROLLMENTS

- COE enrollment data is the initial school history enrollment information currently collected by the recruiter on the COE.

 - NE Code
 - Facility Name
 - School Year
 - Resident Only Checkbox
 - District of Residence

2017-2018 DATA COLLECTION CHANGES - ENROLLMENTS

- Enrollment Transition Goal:
 - To overall reduce COE Change of Data requests by 50%
- What to expect in 2017-2018
 - Data Entry Specialists will be expected to collect all initial School History enrollment data with the exception of the Facility Name



2017-2018 DATA COLLECTION CHANGES – STUDENT HEALTH

- Requirement: Nebraska must collect the following health information for each migrant child:
 - Vision, hearing, & physical exams
 - TB Skin Test
 - Immunization records
 - Medical Alerts
- What to expect in 2017-2018
 - Data Entry Specialists will be expected to collect all available health information for each migrant child.
