



Targeted Teaching Topic

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Summary of Topic:

Simon Says

Main Curriculum Tie:

Knowing the names of bones of the skeletal system. Classify the basic structural and functional organization of the human body including chemical, cellular, tissue, organ, and system.

Required Materials for Lesson:

Background for Teacher:

Skeleton picture for quick reference (both front and back view).

Student Prior Knowledge:

Exposure to the skeleton.

Intended Learning Outcome:

Student will be able to identify the major bones of the skeletal system.

Instructional Procedure:

- Have students stand up.
- Review rules of the game of Simon Says.
- Say names of bones and students touch or point to that bone.
- If Simon didn't say to do it, then they sit down.
- Switch rules and have student be Simon and call out the names of bones.
- Can be done in small groups to involve everyone more actively.

How to Measure Outcome:

Observation of students as the listener and as Simon.
