Summary of Topic:

Hey, They're NOT Doctors!

Main Curriculum Tie:

A research opportunity to find out how other disciplines are connected to medicine. Career exploration, team work, academic foundation, and systems.

Required Materials for Lesson:

A list of careers that are not "typical" medical careers. Examples: business, sanitation, janitorial, art, public relations, finance, electrical engineer, mechanical engineer, computer technology, etc.

Background for Teacher:

Knowledge of how other careers are associated with medicine and an understanding how they all work together.

Student Prior Knowledge:

Intended Learning Outcome:

To learn that there are many other careers and discipline associated with health careers.

Instructional Procedure:

Students choose a discipline and then find out and document (with source) how the career is related to health care and how the health care system depends on these disciplines.

How to Measure Outcome:

Rubric. Students present their findings to the class and then discuss their importance.
