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**Summary of Topic:**

Types of Tissues

**Main Curriculum Tie:**

Structure and function of tissues.

**Required Materials for Lesson:**

- Colored pencils.
- Copier paper.
- Pictures and descriptions of tissues.

**Background for Teacher:**

What each type of tissue looks like and a description of where it is located and what its function is.

**Student Prior Knowledge:**

Tissue types, locations, and functions.

**Intended Learning Outcome:**

To become more familiar with the different types of tissue (appearance, location, function).

**Instructional Procedure:**

- Each student will pick one tissue (such as adipose, osseous, etc.) to draw and color.
- On the back of each tissue, the student will write the name of the tissue, where it is found, and what its function is.
- Each student will share their tissue and description with the class.

**How to Measure Outcome:**

Check to see if the drawing is accurate and if the description (location and functions) are correct.
