Summary of Topic:

Warning Signs of Cancer

Main Curriculum Tie:

Diseases.

Required Materials for Lesson:

Card with the word CAUTION written vertically, write the term on a white board, or project from the computer screen.

Background for Teacher:

First teach the warning signs of cancer. Next day or later in the week, use the following instructional procedure.

Student Prior Knowledge:

Warning signs of cancer have been presented to the students.

Intended Learning Outcome:

Student will be able to list the warning signs of cancer.

Instructional Procedure:

Set: As students enter the room, have them complete the acronym CAUTION:

C Change in bowel or bladder habits.

A A sore throat that does not heal.

U Unusual bleeding or discharge.

T Thickening or a lump in the breast or other area.

I Indigestion or difficulty swallowing.

O Obvious change in a mole or wart.

N Nagging cough or hoarseness.
